State v. Hudson - Instructions

Nita State Statute: Murder in the first degree

- (a) A person commits murder in the *first degree* if
 - (1) Acting alone or with one (1) or more other persons, he commits or attempts to commit a felony, and in the course of and in furtherance of the felony or in immediate flight therefrom, he or an accomplice causes the death of any person under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the value of human life.
- (b) It is an **affirmative defense** to any prosecution under subdivision (a)(1) of this section for an offense in which the defendant was not the only participant and that the defendant:
 - (1) Did not commit the homicidal act or in any way solicit, command, induce, procure, counsel, or aid in its commission; and
 - (2) Was not armed with a deadly weapon.
